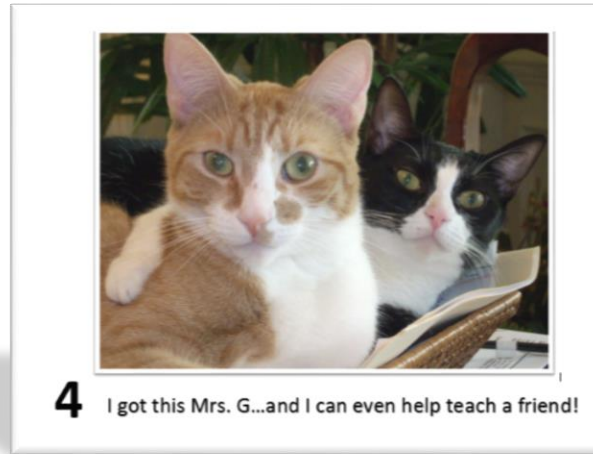


## 3D Exam Review:



**#goals**

Your goal is to show that you have reached LEVEL 4 understanding of the following topics. Level 4 means that you understand and can teach someone else about the topic. Show me that you can do that by completing THREE out of the four informational posters (regular sized paper) or pamphlets about EACH of the following topics;

### POSTER 1: Inspiration Cube (Use your brain/recollection)

- Create a step-by-step explanation of how to do the 'inspiration cube' project
- Include diagrams
- Include tips/techniques
- Make sure to explain the difference between 2D and 3D
- List project goal(s)

### POSTER 2: General Clay Info (Use textbook/phone/student computer)

- Wedging clay (*explain how to wedge, why do we wedge clay*)
- How to protect clay from drying while you work
- How to attach clay (*slip/score definitions, be able to explain/draw diagrams*)
- What are the three hand-building methods
- Include how-to diagram of how to create a slab/ornament
- List project goal(s)

### POSTER 3: Paper Mache Letter (Use textbook/phone/student computer)

- Step by step process of creating letter from idea on paper to 3D letter
- Must include the following vocab with definitions:
  - 3D
  - Paper Mache
  - Form (from elements of art)
  - Font
- List project goal(s)

### POSTER 4: Elements of Art (Use textbook/phone/student computer)

- Create a poster for the Elements
- Must include definitions for each
- Must include a graphic that explains each element
