Please remember to make the work ready for exhibiting by matting or mounting the work with a label giving the student name, title of the work, medium, teacher's name, and school. If you have several pieces from a class project, a short statement about the lesson would be greatly appreciated. Work done in the style of Hispanic Artist or regional Hispanic Art.
