

## 2D Art: Creative Color Wheel Design

### **STEP 1: PLANNING/SKETCHING**

**Use this worksheet for your color wheel planning.** You will create a color wheel design of your choice. The design must include the 48 colors listed below (*each of the twelve 'pure' colors, and then a tint, tone and shade of each color*) The colors DO NOT have to be in the exact order of the color wheel, but they all need to be included in the work.

On **Monday, November 14<sup>th</sup>** you will show me this paper with at least three ideas sketched below **or** on a separate sheet of paper. Note: paper size will be a 12x18 rectangle (*vertical OR horizontal*) unless discussed as a design element.
