DESIGN GUIDELINES:

- ✓ All SDPBC District-run middle and high school students are eligible to participate, however, each student is limited to one entry, and each school is limited to five entries. Schools are encouraged to include all students, and to hold local, school-based competitions to select the five entries to be submitted.
- ✓ All cover designs must be computer generated. Required programs for production of the final design include Adobe Illustrator, Adobe Photoshop, or Adobe InDesign. All designs require pre- flighting in a page layout program.
- ✓ Preflight guides from commercial printers are available that provide invaluable assistance and instruction for students on the pre-press process. Please see these two guides when working with your students:

- √ The design must be submitted electronically by uploading it to the Mickey Schemer Cover Design Entries Google Drive Folder (https://goo.gl/846D0K) at 300 dpi in the original format AND in print format [CMYK color format]. See this document for very important directions (https://goo.gl/74AAaN).
- ✓ Each design must incorporate the SDPBC logo as well as the Technology Conference Logo: https://goo.gl/846D0K.
- ✓ Each student should design a logo to compliment the cover design. The logo will be used on bags and signs and other conference marketing materials, and should include the primary design elements of the cover design.
- ✓ The cover should contain the words: "20 Years of Blazing the Trail". We would like this to be a vector file, but we are OK with high resolution Photoshop files as well.
- ✓ Do not collapse or flatten layers in any source documents. Only the final PDF file should be flattened.
- ✓ All designs must be created and submitted at 100% of the size at which they will be printed. Therefore, the designs may be either a single file in full size dimensions (11" x 17"), or two files with front (8-1/2" X 11") and back (8-1/2" X 11"). There should be a 1/8th inch bleed on each side (totaling 11.25" x 17.25"). NOTE: Graphics may OR may not flow to the back cover (referred to as a "wraparound" cover).
- ✓ Designers should work at a resolution of 300dpi throughout the creation of their program covers.
- √ Fonts must be Windows AND Mac compatible.
- ✓ All fonts and images must be licensed full versions or Creative Commons (marked for reuse), royalty free, or copyright free (no trial versions). Proof of purchase must be included with your submission for all copyrighted material.
- ✓ All work for submitted designs should be **original** artwork and comply with SDPBC copyright policies. Students may use the District provided logos and artwork. Trademarks, company logos, commercial slogans, etc. are not permitted.
- ✓ All entries become the property of the SDPBC. The designer agrees to relinquish any rights that may encumber the use or display of the design by the SDPBC.

✓ All entries *must* include a signed and scanned <u>PBSD 1941 form</u>. If the form is not included in your submission, your entry will not be judged.

✓ All designs must reflect the Conference theme and contain all of the following text in addition to the SDPBC logo and the technology conference logo:

DESIGN SELECTION:

- A Program Cover Design Selection Committee comprised of both District-level and school-based personnel will review and evaluate the conference program cover designs.
- Three finalists will be selected from among the qualifying entries.
- The three finalists will then compete for "Best of Show", the winning designers will receive the following:
 - First Place \$500 and a one-year subscription to Adobe Creative Cloud digital design software tools from Adobe Systems, Inc. for their personal use.
 - Second Place \$250 and a one-year subscription to Adobe Creative Cloud digital design software tools from Adobe Systems, Inc. for their personal use.
 - Third Place \$100 and a one-year subscription to Adobe Creative Cloud digital design software tools from Adobe Systems, Inc. for their personal use.
 - The supporting teacher is also eligible to receive a one-year subscription to Adobe Creative Cloud digital design software tools from Adobe Systems, Inc. for their personal use.
- All entries will be displayed on-site on the day of the Conference.
- The winning design will be featured on the 2018 Technology Conference program cover.
