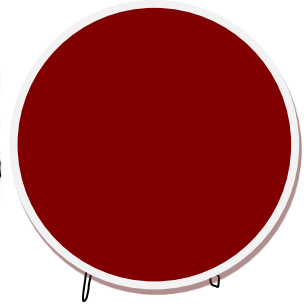


Course: Art 1/ 3D Design

Course Description:

The visual art curriculum at Lake Worth High School contributes to the school and community by promoting creativity and learning to express oneself through the study of art. The Art 1/ 3D Course provides studies in sculpture as students explore new mediums, techniques, styles and subject matter and creates connections between subjects, cultures, and different areas of experience. The units will be based on forms or movements in art history, as well as elements of art and principles of design within 'themes' for each nine weeks, ('Current', 'Classical', 'Contemporary' and 'Contribution') This course at LWSHS focuses on learning about art through a continuing practice of thinking, planning, creating and evaluating art within the framework of the Sunshine State/National Standards for Visual Art.

Class Rules and Procedures:

During the first days of class and as needed throughout the course, the students will review the **Class Rules and Procedures**. Please keep in mind that some procedures are specific to working with certain tools and materials and do to the length these will be covered in a separate document. **All District and Lake Worth High School rules will be observed.**

The four main class rules are as follows;

1. **Safety:** Sit in your assigned area, follow directions.
2. **Open-Mindedness:** Listen. Be kind to others.
3. **Active Learning:** *Be on time. Be prepared. Pay attention. Stay on task.
4. **Respect:** Treat others how you would want to be treated. Take care of the art room and materials.
