

Senior Exam Art/Research Project

Please use the list of artists posted in class as a reference for the exam. It is important that you tell me the specific piece that you will be recreating, there are to be no duplicate pieces. (*It is okay if the same artist is chosen...just not the same piece*) *Hurry*, select your artist/work ASAP so it doesn't get claimed by another student!

Part A, MUST be completed FIRST. On a separate piece of paper, fill out the following information for the piece/artist that you have selected in an informational poster format; (*include catchy title, fun headings, boxes/shapes with information...should be visually interesting to look at and well executed*)

1. Artist Name
2. Artist birth and death date
3. Title of Work
4. Date of Work
5. Book/page number or web link
6. 'ism' (*what 'art movement' is the artist associated with?*)
7. Techniques/Mediums used
8. Quote from the artist
9. Three additional facts related to the artist/work/movement
10. Written statement explaining why you chose this work- what appeals to you about this piece of art.

Part B: You will recreate the piece that you selected on the wooden circle provided. You must reproduce the work as closely as you can. The work will be painted in acrylic paint, and edges should be painted as well.
